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What is Erasmus+?

 Erasmus+ is the EU's programme to support education, training, youth and sport. It finances projects, partnerships and mobility in the fields of education, training, youth and sport.

The total budget available for Erasmus+ between 2021 and 2027 is
 €26.2 billion, plus around €2.2 billion from EU external instruments.



Tunisia is the 3rd country in the southern Mediterranean region in terms of participation in the Erasmus+ Virtual Exchange program after Palestine and Morocco.






Stats of Erasmus+ CBHE projects for Tunisia



Type of activities of CBHE projects involving Tunisia 2015-2020










Indicator of openness to the socio-economic world




Erasmus+ Open Access for research and data
